

Bylaw No.2004-1


GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

A bylaw to provide for penalties for contravention of bylaws.

The Council of the Town of Milestone, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Section 3 and 4 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$500.00 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offence.
5. Bylaw No. 2-70 passed March 18, 1970 is hereby repealed.
