2024 Budget and Tax Policy Information:

The Council passed the Budget on April 2, 2024. The following Tax Policy was applied to the Total Taxable Assessment for the R.M., which amounts to \$131,861,126:

Municipal Mill Rate - 7.70 mills

School Mill Rates - No change from 2023:

- Agricultural Class Property 1.42
- Residential and Seasonal Residential 4.54
- Commercial 6.86 9.88 (varies per assessment)

The 2024 Mill rate has been set at 7.70 mills, an increase of 0.50 mills from the 2023 rate of 7.20 mills. This adjustment results in a Municipal Tax Levy of approximately \$1,015,487.

Municipal Operating Revenues, excluding any capital grant allocations that may be received, total \$1,297,120; Operating Expenses, excluding depreciation of asset calculations and capital purchases, total \$1,295, 945.

Loraas Bins:

Please remember that the waste collection bins in Parry and other areas are for <u>bagged household garbage</u> only. Your cooperation in ensuring that tires, furniture, building materials, etc., ARE NOT deposited in the bins is appreciated. Garbage left on the ground outside the bins will not be cleaned up and collected. If this continues, the service will be cancelled. If the bins require additional dumping, please contact the office.

Loraas Recycle bins for the residents and ratepayers of the RM of Caledonia are located beside the RM shop. If the bins are full or locked, please advise the office.



Our RM currently maintains over 25 bridges, constructed between 60 and 100 years ago. Every five years, SARM engages an independent engineer to inspect bridges in each RM across the province. These inspections aim to ensure safety and identify any deficiencies, potential problems, or safety concerns.

The most recent inspections identified issues with three bridges in our RM. We are collaborating with an engineer to develop a comprehensive strategy for necessary repairs on all our bridges. We have already addressed restrictions on two of the three bridges and committed to addressing all bridge repairs in a fiscally responsible manner.

In 2024, we removed the Concrete Arch Bridge and wooden bridge located at NE 11-12-20 W2. After extensive review with our engineers, it was determined that the most fiscally responsible approach was to replace both bridges with a new, longer bridge. The estimated cost for this project is approximately \$1,600,000. The RM has secured \$500,000 in Provincial and Federal funding for this project. However, rising construction and material costs have influenced budget discussions.

Municipal Wells - SW 14-12-20 W2:

As required by the Saskatchewan Health Authority and the Water Security Agency, the R.M. must inform all users about the non-potable status of the public water supply. There have been no changes to the water supply itself, but a change in health district requirements.

DO NOT USE this water for drinking, cooking, food preparation, or oral hygiene purposes. This water is not treated or tested and is considered unsafe for these uses.

Pest Control Officer and Weed Inspector:

The RM provides rat poison free of charge to its ratepayers. If needed, we can send our Pest Control Officer (PCO) to your location.

Additionally, the RM has a weed inspector available to spray noxious weeds. Please report any locations of concern to your councillor or the office.
